E-Dialog plans Burlington move

An e-mail and data-base marketing services company called e-Dialog will relocate from Lexington to larger quarters in Burlington, its new landlord said.

The landlord is Nordblom Co. Along with its investment affiliate Nordic Properties, Nordblom owns Network Drive at Northwest Park, a 158-acre business campus in Burlington. Plans call for e-Dialog to move into roughly 47,000 square feet of office space at 65 Network Dr. in June, Nordblom said.

Jones Lang LaSalle is the leasing agent for the property, and e-Dialog was represented in the transaction by CB Richard Ellis, Nordblom said.
